CITY COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 18, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Alexander.

A motion was made by Keith Gilley to dispense of the reading of the minutes and approve them. The motion was second by Joyce Jeffreys, with all voting in favor.

Bids were opened on Golf Carts for Deer Run Golf Course. The bids were: Yamaha – \$3,518.00 per car with \$1,575.00 trade –in on 20 cars, total price \$74,040.00 – Club Car (Jerry Pate Turf & Irrigation) \$4,220.58 per car with \$1,200.00 trade-in on 20 car, total price \$102,617.40. E-Z Go did not meet the bid deadline. A motion was made by Joyce Jeffreys to allow the Mayor to review the bids and go with the low bid from Yamaha if the specifications are met. The motion was second by Denise Lovett, with all voting in favor.

Kyle Cornelius with Lakeshore Benefit Alliance met with Council to present an option for the City to reduce the current Blue Cross –Blue Shield plan and obtain a secondary insurance to allow for better coverage with rates either comparable to the current rates or cheaper. The City is currently in a small group plan with Blue Cross and in order to know what the additional plan would be, a quote in the larger group plan would have to be obtained from Blue Cross. Once the quote is obtain, the City will not be able to go back to the small group plan, which could possibly be more than the current plan or it could be less. The Council agreed to have City Clerk Shirley Gilley request a quote for the large group plan. Another meeting will be scheduled with Kyle Cornelius to discuss these options.

The Council discussed the topic of allowing employees and retirees free play at the Golf Course. After the Council's discussion, Mayor Alexander asked the decision be tabled until a later time.

A motion was made by Joyce Jeffreys to allow for the advertising for new garbage truck. The motion was second by Denise Lovett, with all voting in favor.

A motion was made by Denise Lovett to adjourn, second by Joyce Jeffreys, with all voting in favor.
