Allstate Insurance presentation was made by Josh Kelley and Ashley McIntyre to the Council about the option to present to the City savings in taxes to the City and benefits of insurance to the employees through tax credits. The Council ask questions and will be able to vote at next meeting if it is a option they would like to offer employees.

Mayor Weatherwax told the Council that in order to help with being eligible for grants and bond issues along with improving the infrastructure of the sewer system that rates needed to be increased. Council members ask that even with the set increase which took effect in October were there still a need to increase cost. Mayor Weatherwax and Accountant Emily Edwards said that yes that the rates were still lower than a lot of similar size towns.

Mayor Weatherwax ask for Jay Johnson that the Council look at the cost of repairing the Wren Regulator Station at a cost of \$6,410.87.

AMIC insurance Company reimbursed \$6,127.59 for the cost of the repairs caused by lightning at the golf course – so the City was only out the deductible of \$1000.00 for the repairs.
