Mayor Jolly gave a presentation and update from the US Army Corps of Engineers Flooding Issues Plan for the City of Moulton. The study is funded by a two hundred-thousand-dollar federal grant secured by Congressman Robert Aderholt. The study will provide a plan for relief from drainage problems caused by congested creeks in the area.
